

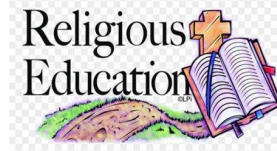
St. John and St. Kateri have started a Seminarian Burse to offer financial help to seminarians from our parishes. A donation envelope can be found in the back of the church.

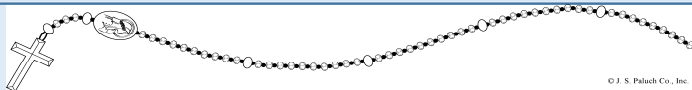
