

CHRISTMAS PAGEANT:



VOCATION CORNER

The **Fourth Sunday of Advent** brings us to the very threshold of Christmas. The tone shifts from joyful anticipation to deep, quiet readiness — the kind of stillness that comes before something



life-changing. Isaiah's prophecy of *Immanuel* reminds us that vocation is not abstract—it is lived in the concrete reality of God's presence. Every call is grounded in the assurance that we are never alone.

Like Joseph, we may not fully understand God's plan, but vocation often begins with a courageous "yes" in the face of uncertainty. He chose obedience over fear, showing that God's call may disrupt our expectations but leads to deeper purpose. God's call is not always loud — sometimes it comes as a whisper in the stillness, asking us to trust and act.

On this 4th Sunday of Advent, ask:

- Where is God inviting me to trust more deeply?
- How can I embody Emmanuel in my relationships, work, or community?
- Am I willing, like Joseph, to embrace a vocation that may challenge my comfort but fulfills God's promise?
