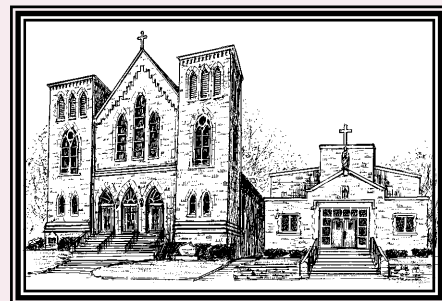

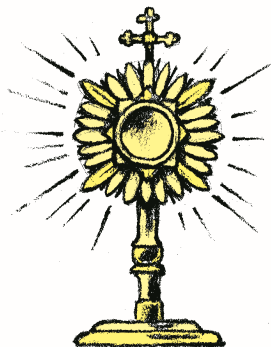

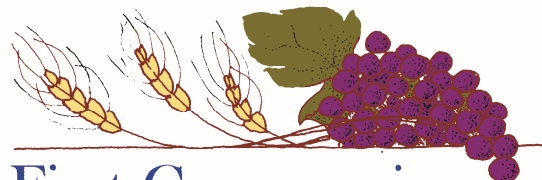
LITURGICAL MINISTERS
