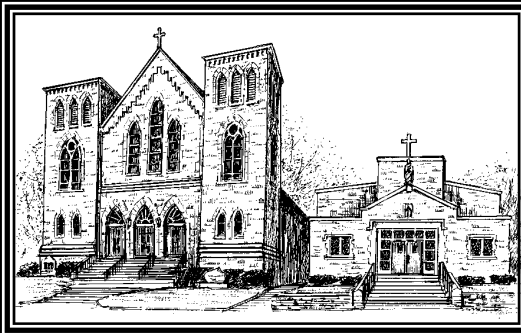

NEW "JUSTFAITH" GROUP FORMING

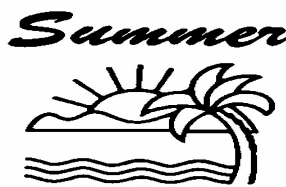

CONCERT INVITATIONS

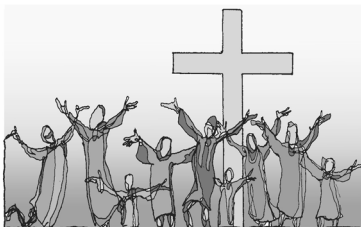
