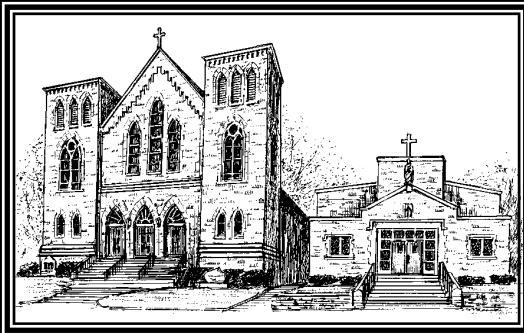

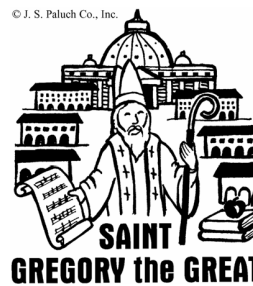
IMMIGRATION LEGAL MATTERS PRESENTATION
