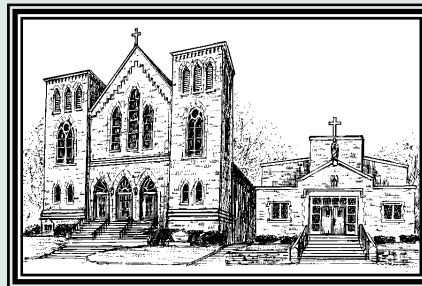

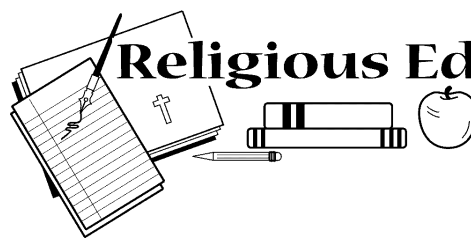
### OCTOBER DEVOTIONS

## BAPTISM PREPARATION CLASS

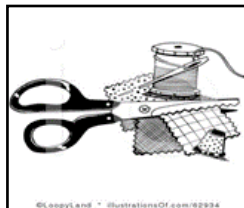
