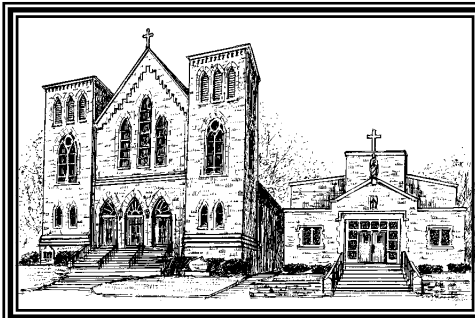

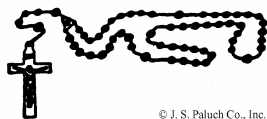

**HURRICANE MICHAEL SPECIAL COLLECTION**

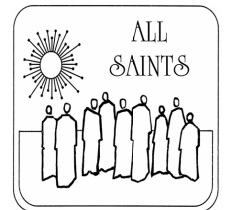
