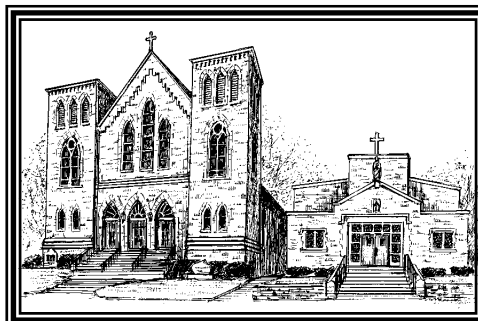

CHURCH CLEANING

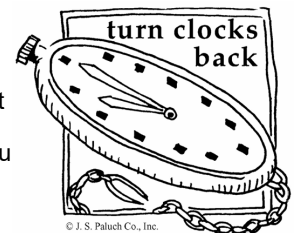

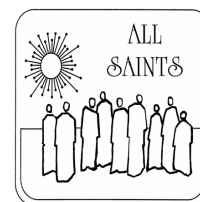
CCD MASS
