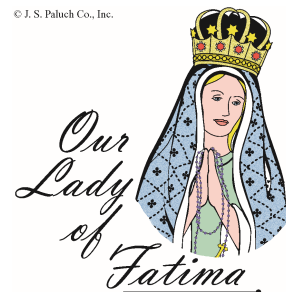

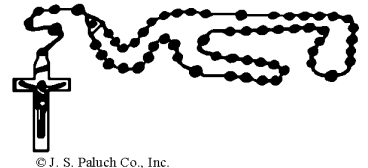
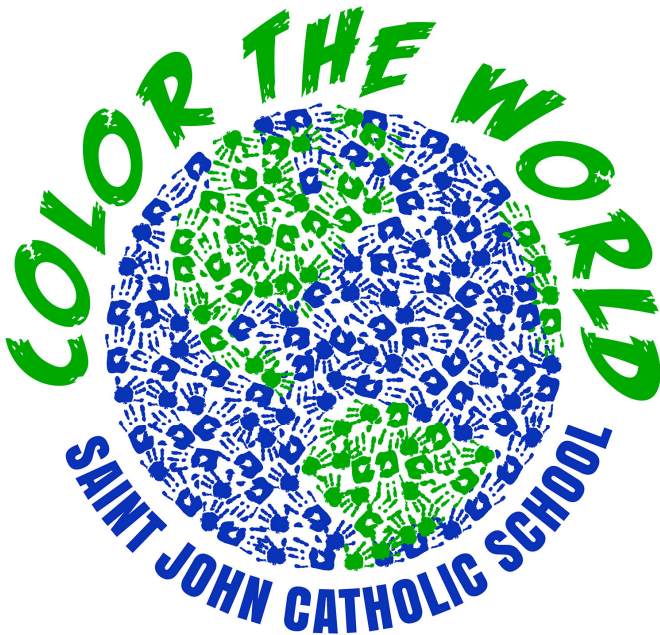
RACE FOR EDUCATION – COLOR THE WORLD
